Greetings Rotarians....

And Happy New Year to all of you! As we welcome 2007 we're already at the halfway point of this Rotary year. The last six months passed quickly, yet we have completed several projects and events while many others are in the works for the second half of the year. Here's a recap.

On the positive side we have inducted three new members with three potential Rotarians in the queue. On the other hand we have lost four valued, long-time members who have left our Club for various reasons. This tells us that we must redouble our efforts to invite our friends and business acquaintances to join us if we are to retain our strength as a productive and energetic Rotary Club. **Beth Lane**, our Membership Chair, is enthusiastic to try her new ideas to make Club growth happen!

We started this Rotary year with a visit from **District Governor Helene Kalfuss** who set us on the right course with her encouraging words. We celebrated our Club's 57th anniversary, recognized **16 new Paul Harris Fellows** and hosted a family potluck dinner at Burnt Mill Beach Club. **We welcomed twenty-four new teachers** to the Rim School District and we celebrated our local **police and fire services** with an **Appreciation Luncheon** at two of our three off-site **Spouses Days at the Resort**.

A solid core group has loyally attended **District events** including a **Membership Workshop** and a **Foundation Seminar** plus we had great representation at this year's **District Foundation Gala Dinner Dance**. Even greater participation is encouraged.

About 20 Rotarians showed up for the **Blue Jay Holiday Parade** (taking 2nd place thanks to **Bob Hill's** choreography), our "**vampires**" volunteered at a couple of **Blood Drives**, and faithful members **helped clean up Highway 18**.

We've **donated thousands of dollars** to worthy and needy community groups, we've rekindled a newly energized **Interact Club** (thanks to **Debra and Beth**) and we've partnered with the **Crestline Rotary Club** to help bring **Exchange Student Agatha Lemunier** from France to our community for the school year. These are but a few of our many highlights worth mentioning.

And now for **Part Deux**....there is so much yet to do. In fact, there are more exciting projects and events planned for the next six months than during the first! And to be successful, every one of them will require the participation of all our Club members.

District events like the January 12th "**Who Touched You**" evening with **Past RI President Richard King**, the **President's Advance** (January 20th) and the **District 5330 Conference** in May will provide opportunities for all of you to experience Rotary at it's next level.

Before the end of June we will "**cut the ribbon**" at **Rotary Centennial Park**, help build a new home in **Tecate, Mexico**, travel to **Pass Christian, Mississippi** to help fellow Rotarians rebuild their tornado-torn community, help drill water wells for drought-stricken residents in **Kenya** and renew our effort to supply **wheelchairs** to those unable to walk.

Several of our Club's members and their spouses will travel on a **Rotary-sponsored trip to China** in March. (There may still be an opportunity for any latecomers to join them). All Rotarians are invited and President-Elect Lacy Kelly is already scheduled to attend the **2007 Rotary International Convention in Salt Lake City, Utah**. We'll top off the 2006-2007 Rotary year with our annual **Rotary Art & Wine Festival** that is already well along in the planning stages under the auspices of **President Designate Joe Ramos**.

Our Club just completed an election and two new board members, **Beth Lane and Paula Porter** have been seated in advance of their two year terms which start July 1, 2007. Others who ran for office are to be commended for volunteering to serve to help our Club. I look forward to working closely with all of them.

Again, these are just the *highlights* of the coming six months. I'm asking every Lake Arrowhead Rotarian to make their own personal resolution to get more involved in the operation of this club...to make it grow, make it stronger, more energetic and more fun!
